MUSEUM HOLDS OLD BOOK SALE

Local historians are planning their first ever book sale to raise funds for the town's Museum.

Following on from a *Shed Sale* in March which raised £443, Bognor Regis Local History Society are hoping to repeat the success, and generate further funds to put towards a project to extend the display area, so that an original Bognor Bathing Machine can be put on show.

Curator Chris Burstow explained “We have over the years accumulated a considerable quantity of old books, theatre programs and ephemera that don't really fit in with our collection. Many relate to Sussex, family and general history. Plus we have quite a few duplicates of local history books relating to Bognor including some old town guides, so this will be a great opportunity for keen local collectors to acquire some out-of-print editions. I'm not saying that there aren't a few limited rare first editions amongst them, but who knows! Not only will this generate further funds towards our plans to expand, but it will help make space for our ever growing collection.”

The sale is being held this Saturday 6 June 10am-4pm at the Museum in West Street.
